



## Word Splits All-Day Sprint

**Instructions:** The goal is to fill in the blank boxes with one letter each to form *two* mathematical words either vertically or horizontally. The boxes you must fill in are the letters which are *the same* in both words. The letters already filled in are the letters that are different. For example, filling the boxes in the example in the top left corner with the letters “P”, “R” and “S” produces the mathematical words “proofs” and “primes”. All of the words have mathematical meanings.
